Dr Andreja KUTNAR is a full professor in the field of wood science at the University of Primorska in Koper, Slovenia and director of the <u>InnoRenew</u> <u>CoE</u>. InnoRenew CoE, together with EPF, is one of the founders of the <u>Wood4Bauhaus Alliance</u>.

Dr Kutnar was an Executive Board member of <u>InnovaWood</u> for six years and in the years 2020/2021 president of the <u>Society of Wood Science and</u> <u>Technology</u>.

Her areas of expertise include wood composites, therm- hydro-mechanical treatment of wood, and adhesive bonding. Her work focuses on research projects in the fields of natural science, technology, sustainable development of the wood industry, environmental impact assessment of new materials, products, and technologies from origin, manufacturing, use/alteration to reuse or recycle.

In 2018, she received the distinguished Zois Certificate of Recognition for important scientific achievements in the field of wood science. And in 2020, she was included in the prestigious European Commission campaign #EUwomen4future that draws attention to outstanding women working in research, innovation, education, culture and sport. Mrs Alicja Magdalena HERBOWSKA started her career in the European Institutions in 2005, in the Secretariat General of the European Commission. She then held the post of Coordinator for European Parliament at the Commission's DG JUST. She went on to work for the European Parliament, where she coordinated the parliamentary hearings of new Commissioners in 2014 and where she was also responsible for the European Citizens' Initiative. In 2015, Ms Herbowska returned to the European Commission to take up the post of Deputy Head of Cabinet of Commissioner Tibor Navracsics and later to deal with Knowledge Management as Deputy Head of Unit at the Commission's Joint Research Centre.

From 2018 to 2020, she was detached from the European Commission to the European Economic and Social Committee to fulfil the role of Head of Cabinet of the President.

She is currently Deputy Head of Unit of the <u>New European Bauhaus</u> at the <u>Joint Research Centre</u>. Ms Herbowska was educated at the Poznan University of Economics and Exeter University (Erasmus Double MA degree) and the European University Institute in Florence. In her free time, she enjoys dancing (tango argentino, 5Rythms), practicing yoga and meditation.



Mrs Vanesa BAÑO is a Dr. in Forest Engineering (PhD) from <u>Universidad de</u> <u>Santiago de Compostela</u>, with 20-year experience in timber construction from both scientific and professional backgrounds. Currently, she works as a project manager of European projects at <u>InnovaWood</u> (Brussels), the European network in wood research, innovation, and education in wood science and technology. Her scientific background was conducted in four different institutions: at the technological research centres <u>Cesefor</u> (2019-2022) and <u>Cetemas</u> (2009-2012) and in Spain; as an aggregated and then associate professor at <u>Universidad de la República</u> in Uruguay (2013-2019), being currently a part-time free docent there; and at Universidad de Santiago de Compostela (2003-2004) in Spain.

Her professional expertise was as a timber structural engineer at <u>Media Madera, Ingenieros</u> <u>Consultores</u> (2004-2008) in Spain and <u>Oak Ingeniería</u> (2018-2021) in Uruguay. As scientific indicators, she has published 31 scientific papers indexed in Scopus, included new wood species for structural purposes in national and European standards, and supervised 4 doctoral theses in four different countries (Spain, Uruguay, Chile, and Brazil).









Mr José PEDRO SOUSA is an Architect graduated by <u>FAUP</u> (Porto) and a PhD in Architecture by <u>IST-UTL (Lisbon)</u>.

During his doctoral studies, he was a special student at MIT (Cambridge, MA) and a Visiting Scholar at UPenn (Philadelphia, PA).

Since 2009, he has been Professor at FAUP teaching courses related to geometry and digital technologies. At FAUP, he founded and directs the <u>Digital Fabrication Laboratory</u> (DFL), which is a research group from CEAU-FAUP dedicated to exploring the impact of technologies such as computational design, digital fabrication, additive manufacturing, robotics or XR technologies, on the thinking and practice of architectural design. Among

other research achievements, he was the PI of a FCT Research project on robotic technologies in architecture and of several collaborations with large industrial companies such as Amorim and Mota Engil.

Before FAUP, he was Professor of <u>FCTUC (Coimbra)</u>, <u>ESARQ-UIC (Barcelona)</u> and <u>IAAC (Barcelona)</u>.

In the last 2 decades, his professional activity combined the fields of teaching, research and practice, exploring the new conceptual and material opportunities emerging from the use of digital technologies in architecture. His work at all these levels has been regularly featured at international conferences and invited lectures, it has been published in leading international magazines and peer-reviewed publications, and it has received several distinctions such as the FEIDAD '05, the Young Researcher Award 2009 of UL/CGD in architecture, or the Pedagogical Innovation Award from the UP in 2017 and 2018. Among other dissemination actions, he was the co-chair of the joint Conference between the associations of eCAADe (Europe) and SIGraDi (iberoamerican), which took place at FAUP in 2019 under the theme of "Architecture in the Age of the 4th Industrial Revolution".

Since March 2021, he has been a member of the <u>High-Level Roundtable of the New European</u> <u>Bauhaus initiative</u>.
