


- All wood-based panel types (Particleboard, MDF, OSB, Hardand Softboard, Plywood)

- All furniture segments contracted in 2023
- Sustained inflation limited the purchasing power of household



Civil engineering construction performed better thanks to public funds




2023 WBP Production in EPF Countries down -6.3% towards 2015 levels



- Output was affected by sustained economic situation
- A slowdown of contraction from -12% in H1-2023 to just -3% in H2 2023

- Slight increase in construction end-uses







- Stable usage of roundwood (less than 1/4!)




MDF – production in EU27+UK+EFTA









OSB Production in EU27+UK+EFTA











Easing pressure of coniferous plywood imports

OSB announced capacity expansion projects in 2024







Hardboard – production in EU27+EFTA







Softboard Production in EU27+EFTA










Plywood Production in EU-27






Plywood capacity expansions in 2023 and beyond





1) Advocacy 2024-2029 Role Model Industry











1) Advocacy 2024-2029 Role Model Industry

- Raise role 2024-2029 from wood, bioeconomy and industry
- Wood sector ("What we can contribute")
 - Circular Choices: Focus on wood, paper, fibre industries' contribution in period 2024-2029. 20% climate contribution (3S) -> 30% in 2030
 - WoodPoP: Member State led, Sector supported activity with much promise. Policy paper in development. 17.5 million jobs, 7% of GDP
- Bioeconomy sector ("A 7 billion euro opportunity")
 - Clean transition dialogues (Green Deal). Direct discussion with EVP Sefcovic. Emphasis on recycled wood/resource efficiency. Well received.
 - Need to give teeth to Bioeconomy in new mandate. Review end 2025.
- Industry sector ("Reindustrialise Europe")
 - Antwerp Declaration. European Industrial Deal to complement the Green Deal. keep high quality jobs for European workers in Europe.
 - 1235 organisations, 25 sectors, industry and trade unions. First, declaration, now movements. Highest level access yet.



2) Wood Availability How much wood is there, what is it used for, is it enough?

How much wood is there?

• 500 million m³ harvested in 2021 in EU-27 (Eurostat)

What is it used for?

- 40% products, 60% energy (EPF calculation from JRC)
- 49% products, 51% energy (JRC, incl. secondary sources)

Is it enough?.....

- Major studies performed by AFRY and SLU
- Change of course is needed (or there will be shortages)
- Various scenarios and ways to debottleneck
- Analysis by EPF then advocacy

Early hint on content?

- Yes.....
- Cascade use/resource efficiency

Regulatory Affairs



2) Regulatory Affairs Formaldehyde & Melamine

Formaldehyde

- 2022 highlight with new limit value (1/2 E1)
- Pan-European harmonisation (and also for imports)
 - => "Sensible" regulation achieved with industry

Melamine

- Challenging dossier for industry to deal with
- Outstanding value chain cooperation from the start
- Legal opposition and also engagement in REACH process
- Detailed scientific and economic feedback to consultations
- EPF accepted as accredited stakeholder at ECHA
- Advocacy to be pursued in Brussels, Helsinki and MSs
 - => United industry targets similarly "sensible" outcome



At Unilin Bazeilles, we witnessed firsthand the intersection of cuttingedge technology and #sustainable practices. From state-of-the art machinery to eco-conscious processes, high-level contributions to #resourceefficiency prevail.

Observing innovative technologies recycling #MDF and #HDF waste back into MDF/HDF manufacture in the fully automated #Osiris pilot line was the main highlight of the tour, as the company has been investing for many years in such innovation, with the aim of replacing at least 25% of raw materials mix for MDF and HDF boards with recycled fibres in the future.

Recovering wood fibres from boards in an economically viable way and reusing them to produce high-quality fibreboards on an industrial scale,
